This is a residential side street, not the Woodward that runs through Detroit). From Woodward, turn right (North) on N. Oak Street. From N. Oak St. turn left (West) on North Hill Circle. North Hill Circle will deadend in the Dinosaur Hill parking lot. Street parking is allowed on North Hill Circle until dusk.
